Sub: Maintaining publication ethics – reg.

The current scenario has brought to light instances of simultaneous submission of research papers to multiple journals or submitting similar articles to different journals. This practice contradicts established publication ethics. To preempt such unethical conduct, it is strongly advised that all Officers and staff (both regular and contractual), along with SRFs, exercise vigilance in upholding publication ethics.

It is vital that a research paper submitted to one journal is not concurrently submitted or communicated to another until the paper's publication or rejection status is determined by the journal of initial submission.

The Council is empowered to undertake suitable ethical measures in response to observed or identified deviations or misleading practices in research paper publication, particularly concerning simultaneous submissions to multiple journals.

Therefore, all Officers, staff, and SRFs of the Council are hereby duly informed and encouraged to uphold and adhere to the highest standards of publication ethics. Striving for strict compliance with the above points is imperative to maintain the integrity of our practices.
