The CCRAS invites sealed quotations in two bid system (Technical and Financial) from NABL/Ministry of AYUSH recognized Laboratories under Rule 160 A to J of D&C Act 1940 for testing parameters of package rates for Ayurvedic Drugs: -

2. General Information about the tender: -

3. The tender shall be submitted in sealed envelope clearly super scribing on the envelope "Bid for testing parameters of package rates for Ayurvedic Drugs". The sealed tender may be put in the tender box placed on 2nd Floor near in the chamber of Dy. Director (Admn), Room No. 222, CCRAS, by due date and time. Tenders received late will be rejected outright.

4. The tender shall be subject to the following conditions: -

- I. The contract should initially for period of one year and will be extended up to three years subject to performance of firm on the same rate, terms and conditions.
- II. The firm should not handover execution of order to any other/sister firm (s) and in such a case it will amount to violation of contract and may entail cancelation of contract and forfeiture of Performance security.
- III. The tenders will be opened on stipulated date and time mentioned at S. No. 2 in the presence of tenders or their authorized representatives who may like to be present.
- IV. If any tenderer withdraws his tender before the expiry of the period fixed for keeping the rates firm for acceptance the earnest money, if any, deposited will be forfeited and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained thereafter.

- V. Technical bid (Annexure-I) and the Financial bid (Annexure-II & III) should be sealed by bidder in separate covers duly superscripted and both these sealed covers are to be put in bigger cover which should also be sealed and duly super subscribed **“Tender for testing parameters of package rates for Ayurvedic Drugs”**.
- VI. The financial bids will be opened only for opening for those firms who qualify in the technical bid. Intervention of the firm in this regard will not be entertained in any form.
- VII. Each tender should submit with an EMD of Rs. 500/- along with the package rate for testing parameters of Ayurvedic drugs as mentioned Annexure-I and II. EMD should be in the form of Demand Draft, drawn in favour of Director General, CCRAS, New Delhi. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders will be refunded after the bids are finalized and successful bidder should submit a security deposit amount of Rs. 2500/- in the form of Demand Draft, drawn in favour of Director General, CCRAS, New Delhi.
- VIII. In case where a successful tenderer, does not supply the items in full or in time the Council as its discretion may get such items from the next higher tenderer and the loss, if any, caused to the Council due to increased rates shall be borne by the defaulting tenderer.
- IX. The Director General has every right to reject/accept any bid without assigning any reasons.
- X. The sample should be analyzed within 15 days from the date of receipt.
- XI. After completion of testing/analysis of the samples, duplicate bills along with detailed report should be sent to the council for release of payment.
- XII. No extra charge will be paid for repeat analysis.
- XIII. The payment will be released digitally through concerned section of Council.
- XIV. If any manipulation is found in the test report, the Council reserves the right to terminate the rate contract without notice or assigning any reason thereof.
- XV. This contract shall also be applicable for peripheral Institutes of Council as demand basis.
