

- National Vrkshayuuveda Research Institute (NVARI) Jhansi established in the year 1973, renamed as Central Ayurveda Research Institute in Dec 2020, is engaged in quality control and Ayurvedic formulation preparation / development.
- Quality Control Laboratory and Ayurvedic pharmacy of "CCRAS-CARI, JHANSI" is an integral part of Central Ayurveda Research Institute (CARI), Jhansi. Quality Control Laboratory of "CCRAS-CARI, JHANSI", was established at the Central Ayurveda Research Institute, Jhansi, in the year 2021, QC Laboratory having different sections like Chemistry, Pharmacognosy & Microbiology equipped with variety of advanced analytical instruments which are operated and maintained by a dedicated and qualified Scientists and Technical Staff. This institute having integrated Pharmacy Section for the development of various dosages forms of ASU drugs.
- In order to document the quality standard of medicinal plants, NRDR have been funded by NMPB Ministry of AYUSH. NRDR would play a stellar role in collection, documentation, and authentication of raw drugs collected largely from the respective agro-climatic region.
- The Institute having herbarium section where more than 24000 accessioned specimens of 205 families, 1129 genera and 2563 species are housed and maintained. The herbarium has been registered with index herbarium and allotted the acronym JHS.
