NOTICE TO CANDIDATES

Kindly refer Advertisement No. 04 /2015 for Conduct of Computer Based Test for Recruitment to the post(s) of Research Officer(s) and Statistical Officer in CCRAS. The computer based test is scheduled to be held on **7th May, 2016 (Saturday)** as per details given below:

09.00 AM - 10:10 AM	-Ayurveda -Pharmacognosy	The question paper shall be objective type consisting of 70 multiple choice questions (70 marks)
12 Noon - 1:10 PM	-Chemistry -Statistical Officer	The question paper will be divided into three parts:
03.00 PM - 04:10 PM	-Publication -Bio-Chemistry -Pharmacology -Homeopathy -Medicine -Pathology	Part-I (35 marks) , based on concerned subject knowledge. Part-II (25 marks) 25 questions on Research Methodology. Part-III 10 questions on General knowledge and Reasoning and Information technology and computing. There will be 0.25 marks negative marking for each wrong answer.

- The candidate must bring e-Admit Card at the Examination Centre alongwith his/her one of the photo identification card in original viz. Voter Identity Card, Driving License, PAN Card, Unique ID Card/Passport or Aaddhar Card. The identity of the candidate will be matched from the proof at the time of entering into the examination center main gate and also during the examination. The Candidates are also advised to bring 02 additional recent colored passport size photographs in the examination centre on the day of examination. No candidate will be allowed to enter without this e-Admit Card and Original photo Identity card.
- The candidates are requested to reach / report Examination centre as per Reporting Time given in the e-admit card.** Bring Black/Blue Ball Point pens for solving the questions on rough paper. The rough paper shall be provided at the examination centre. **There will be 0.25 marks negative marking for each wrong answer.**
- The reporting time for 1st session examination is 7.30AM, 2nd Session examination is 10.30AM and for 3rd Session at 1.30PM. **The main gate will be closed before half an hour from the commencement of the test i.e. 8.30 AM for 1st session / 11.30AM for 2nd session and 2.30PM for 3rd session. Late coming is NOT allowed under any circumstances.**
- Demo/mock test is available for practice purpose at CCRAS website www.ccras.nic.in
- Provisional e-Admit Cards link** based on the prima facie information provided by the candidates in the application have been dispatched to all the provisionally eligible candidates in their registered email-ID address on **17th April, 2016 (Please check in the SPAM mail also)**. The candidature of the candidates appearing in the examination is **"Purely Provisional" subject to scrutiny of their documents at the time of verification of documents after conduct of the examination.** Those candidates whose name is in the list of eligible candidates and who have not received the e-Admit Cards by **19th April, 2016** may download their e-admit cards from CCRAS website www.ccras.nic.in
- A "Facilitation Counter" shall also be functional in each of the city of examination to address the concerns of the candidates and facilitate e-admit card related queries. The address of "Facilitation Counter" in each of the city of examination is available on the CCRAS's website. The "Facilitation Counter" shall be operational on **06th May, 2015 (Friday)** from 1000 hrs to 1200 hrs. No request for change in city of the examination centre shall be entertained under any circumstances.
- Possession and use of electronic devices such as Calculator, Mobile Phone, Micro Phone or any other Associated Accessories, Log Tables, pager, Digital Diary, Book/ Notes, wrist watch etc. are strictly prohibited in the Examination Hall. If any candidate is found in possession of any of these devices / documents then his/her candidature is liable to be cancelled. The Candidate **should not bring any Mobile Phone / Micro Phone etc.** at the Examination Centre. CCRAS will not be responsible for its safe custody / loss. The details printed on the e-admit card must be checked by the candidate. In case your e-admit card mentions some other post / discipline or without photograph/signature then candidate is advised to bring 2 passport size photographs along with documentary evidence/proof in the examination centre so that necessary corrections are made in the record.
