

Folklore Claims of Kadukottambari (*Ruta chalepensis* Linn.)

*Medico Ethnobotanical study of a local drug called "Kadukottambari" (*Ruta chalepensis*) used by some villagers of Bangalore, Mysore and Tumkar districts and the folklore claims regarding the usefulness of this drug on Indralupta (*Alopacia*), Vandhya karana (Contraception), Vicharchika (Eczema), Vyoshonmada (Hysteria), Shwasa vikaras (Respiratory disorders), Pakshaghata (Paralysis), Bala pakshaghata (Poliomyelitis), Teevra jwara (High fever), Gridhrasi (Sciatica) in human beings and stabdhata and Pakshaghata (stiffness & Paralysis) in animals have been explored.*
