On Comparative Values of Indian and Chinese Medicinal Plants

Fifty-eight plant species, commonly used as crude drugs in the Indian and Chinese systems of medicine are listed in this paper. Distinctive use of each species is recorded. These crude drug plants are commonly found in the drug stores, the Chinese crude drugs in Malaya and the Indian crude drugs in all Indian bazars. The geographical distribution of each species, as found in India, is also given.
