

CULTIVATION OF SOME PHARMACEUTICALLY IMPORTANT MEDICINAL PLANTS IN ITANAGAR (ARUNACHAL PRADESH)

This paper deals with 56 species of pharmaceutically important medicinal plants with special reference to Ayurveda, cultivated in the agro-climatic conditions of Itanagar, either growing in different parts of Arunachal Pradesh or obtained from other parts of the Country. Some of the plants obtained from higher elevation or very dry climatic conditions could not be acclimated, have also been discussed in this paper.
