

MEDICO-BOTANICAL SURVEY OF SAPI VALLEY OF KARGIL (LADAKH HIMALAYAS)

The present study deals with 22 medicinal plants of Sapi Valley of Kargil district of Ladakh Himalayas traditionally used for treatment of various ailments in Amchi System of Medicine.
