## Availability of Medicinal Plants in Rehekurri Sanctuary (Karjat Taluka) of Ahmadnagar District, Maharashtra

Botanical collection tours along the 100 kilometers road track (to Rehekuri) via Ghogargaon of Shrigonde Taluka were undertaken during October, December and March, 1995-1996. The paper presents climate and vegetation together with a comprehensive analysis of the floristic composition and its comparison with Ahmadnagar town, map showing area surveyed, enumeration of the species collected and medicinal or local uses.
