A SURVEY ON HERBACEOUS ETHNO-MEDICINAL PLANTS USED IN THE TREATMENT OF VARIOUS AILMENTS PREVALENT IN THE BHIL TRIBE OF RATLAM DISTRICT (M.P.) INDIA

Frequent ethnomedicinal surveys were conducted between August 2004 to March 2007 in different villages of Ratlam district. Results of these surveys indicated that 30 herbaceous species are interestingly used for the treatment of different type of diseases prevalent in the Bhil community of the district. Botanical names followed by family, local names, Ayurvedic Names and the ethnomedicinal uses have been provided.
