

ETHNO-MEDICINAL STUDIES ON PLANTS USED IN THE TREATMENT OF URINO-GENITAL DISEASES BY BHIL TRIBE OF RATLAM DISTRICT (M.P.)

Frequent ethnomedicinal surveys were conducted during August 2004 to March 2007 in different tribal inhabited villages of Ratlam District (M. P.). Results of these surveys indicated that 34 plant species are interestingly used for the treatment of urinogenital diseases prevalent in the Bhil tribe of the district. Botanical names followed by family, local names and the ethnomedicinal uses have been provided.
