Abstract

The paper deals with the report on the medico ethno botanical exploration of the state of Mizoram covering various forest divisions and ranges in Kolasib, Aizawl, Darlawn and Champhai districts. The state as a whole is a hilly land with varying elevation from foot hills to subtropical range of vegetation. During the course of study, medicinal plants used in Ayurveda and other system of medicines were recorded and 13 folk medicinal claims have also been reported in this paper.
