Alkaloids from *Agaru*

Agaru is an aromatic drug used in Indian Systems of Medicine. It has been described as stimulant, cardiac tonic and carminative and finds place in several compound preparations (Chopra et al 1956). *Agaru* is also used as cosmetic and liniment in various skin diseases. Alkaloids isolated from *Agaru* are reported in the paper.
