

Statistical Data of Service Oriented Survey and Surveillance Study and Community Health Care Research Programme of Krishna District (Andhra Pradesh)

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Abstract

The Services Oriented Survey and Surveillance and Community Health Care Research Programme was conducted in fourteen villages of Krishna district of Andhra Pradesh by Regional Research Institute (Ayurveda), Vijayawada, (A.P.) with the aim of providing service oriented health care facilities to the rural people and to collect vital statistical data constituting personal hygiene, food habits, addictions, occupation, prevalence of diseases and life style of the rural people. From the door to door survey it was observed that majority of villages having poor sanitation, lack of safe drinking water facility, poor transportation, poor health care services and low literacy rate. It was observed that in these area, gynecological disorders, skin diseases, vata vyadhies, acid peptic disorders, respiratory problems, fever, anemia, oral cavity diseases etc are mainly prevailed due to poor personnel hygiene, lack of health awareness, low socio economic conditions and non availability & inaccessible primary health care services. The team has put their efforts by explaining necessary preventive measures to the patients. On the completion of study it was found that majority of the prevailing diseases were well responded to the Ayurvedic treatment.

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
