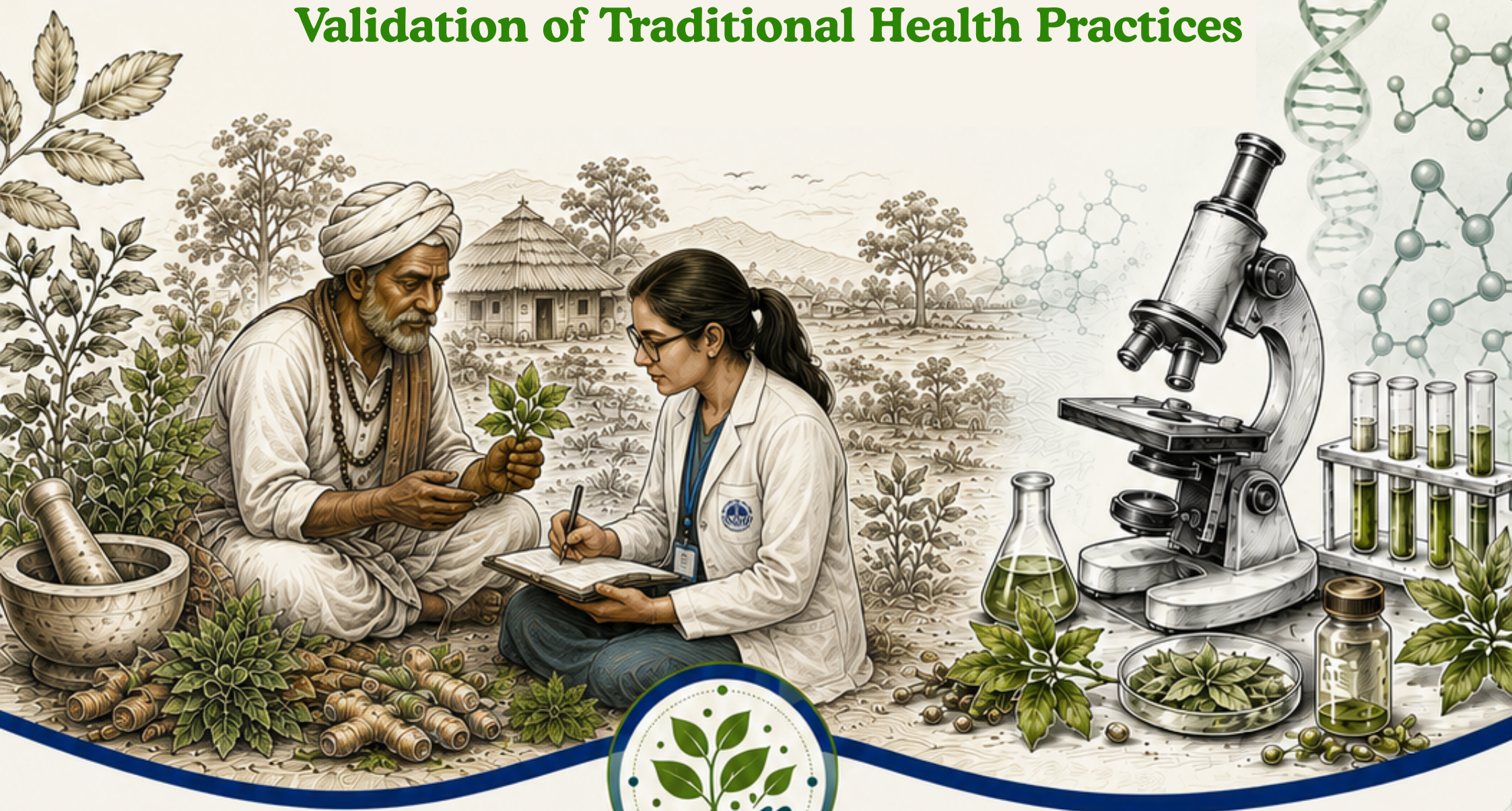


Documentation, Assessment & Scientific Validation of Traditional Health Practices

OBJECTIVES



To undertake systematic documentation and validation of Local Health Traditions (LHTs), Oral Health Traditions (OHTs), and Ethnomedical Practices (EMPs)



To undertake systematic documentation and validation of Ethnoveterinary practices



To undertake research studies (preclinical / clinical, etc.) of suitable claims/practices based on their scientific merit.
